AFTER EXTENSIVE PLANNING, THE POWER LINE UPGRADES ARE READY TO BEGIN MID-FEBRUARY!
Stronger poles. Same power today. Planning for tomorrow.

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Southern Utah Valley Power Systems (SUVPS) will be upgrading the existing transmission line in your area.

As part of this work:

- Existing **~60-foot wooden poles** will be removed
- New **~80-90-foot steel poles** will be installed in the same corridor
- This improves **strength, safety, and long-term reliability**

WILL THE POWER LEVEL CHANGE?

Not right now.

The line will continue operating at the **same voltage** as it does today.

However, the new poles are designed **to accommodate a future higher voltage line** as local power needs grow.

This project ensures the line is ready — **before** demand becomes a problem.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR NEARBY RESIDENTS

You may notice:

- Taller steel poles replacing older wooden poles
- Temporary construction activity
- Crews and equipment in the corridor
- Short-term access or work area adjustments

We understand projects like this raise questions about:

- Tree trimming
- Visual changes
- Construction timing
- Access
- Safety

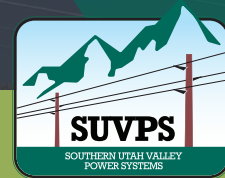
