

To meet the growing energy needs of our communities, **SUVPS** is launching Phase I of the **Power Grid Improvement Program**. As part of this effort, surveying and geotechnical testing will begin as early as February 24 and continue through **Spring.** This work involves drilling test holes at various locations in **Spanish Fork** to collect soil samples for evaluation.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

**TESTING LOCATIONS** – Drilling will take place along the existing power line route, starting at the Canyon Road substation and continuing along 400 South, Scenic Drive, Arrowhead Trail, Del Monte Road, and 900 South, ending west of I-15 at the site of a planned substation. (See map for details.)

MINIMAL DISRUPTIONS - While we anticipate minimal disturbances, residents may experience temporary increases in noise from drilling activities.

**SAFETY MEASURES** – Work areas will be marked, and some traffic closures may be necessary. Utility lines will be identified and protected before drilling begins.
